#### STUDENT AGREEMENT

1. I understand that the Internet can connect me to much useful information stored on computers around the world.
2. While I have access to the internet:
  - a. I will use it only for education purposes.
  - b. I will not look at, or participate in, anything illegal, dangerous, offensive, or opposed to, the Adventist values of this school.
  - c. I will not reveal home addresses or phone numbers – mine or anyone else's.
  - d. I will not use the Internet to annoy, offend or bully anyone else.
3. If I accidentally come across something that is illegal, dangerous or offensive, I will:
  - a. Clear any offensive pictures or information from my screen immediately.
  - b. Immediately and quietly inform my teacher.
4. I understand that if any intentional damage is done to the computer due to any Internet activities, the cost of repair will be the responsibility of my parents.
5. I understand that if the school decides that I have broken these rules, appropriate action will be taken. Any activity not in compliance with these rules may result in a loss of access, as well as, other disciplinary, or legal action.
