# DRESS CODE

Students are required to follow the Mayfair's Dress Code every day. All MCS uniforms may be purchased from Sidney Ryan Uniforms in Akron or online through www.frenchtoast.com.

## **REQUIRED FOR ALL STUDENTS**

### 1. <u>Required MCS Polo Shirts: Navy Blue, Light Blue and Yellow</u>

- a. All polo shirts must have the MCS logo on them.
- b. Short sleeve or long sleeve MCS polo shirts may be worn.
- c. Each student must own at least 3 shirts.
- d. No long sleeved shirts will be permitted under short-sleeved polo's.

#### 2. Optional MCS Hoodies/Fleece – Navy Blue

- a. MCS logo hoodie
- b. MCS logo zip up sweater
- c. MCS logo lined jacket
- d. No other hoodies or cardigans/sweaters will be permitted, ALL MUST HAVE MCS LOGO.
- 3. Required Dress Pants/Slacks: Tan or Navy
  - a. Docker or jogger style pants/slacks are required no denim, no cargo pants, no jeggings and no stretch pants are permitted. No BLACK pants or shorts are permitted.
  - b. Pants/slacks must be of an appropriate size (not baggy or tight).
  - c. Black belts are encouraged to be worn.

#### 4. Optional Shorts or Skirts/Scooters: Tan or Navy (weather permitting)

- a. Docker style shorts (no cargo pockets)
- b. Must have sewn cuff/hem close to the knees.
- c. Skirts/Scooters must reach to the top of the knee and wear shorts or leggings underneath.

#### 5. Required Shoes/Tennis Shoes:

- a. Tennis shoes are the only shoes permitted in the classroom and gymnasium.
- b. Shoes should have non-marking soles.
- c. Socks must be worn with all shoes.
- d. No dress shoes will be permitted.
- e. Boots may be worn to and from school and for outside use, but not in the classrooms or gymnasium.

#### 6. Gym Wear

a. All students are required to wear a MCS gym uniform, which consists of a MCS logo shirt and MCS logo shorts or pants.

#### 7. Required Formal Dress Uniform

a. Each parent is responsible for purchasing a formal uniform for each student. This uniform must be purchased through the French Toast webpage for our school.

#### 8. Clothing or Items NOT acceptable:

- a. Hats, head bandannas (do-rags), or head-wraps, except for religious purposes.
- b. No form fitting clothing.
- c. Clothing that is torn or has holes or that is not clean.
- d. Make-up, colored nail polish (finger and/or toes), fake nails, un-natural hair coloring.
- e. With the exception of a wrist-watch, no jewelry is to be worn; including, but not limited to: rings, bracelets, earrings, toe rings, tongue rings, necklaces, etc.

#### 9. Dress Code Enforcement:

- a. Students violating the dress code will not be permitted to enter the classroom until the parent/guardian has been called and the appropriate attire has been brought for the child.
- b. Additionally, please note that jewelry or hats may be confiscated.
